<u>DISTRICT CONVENTIONS</u> Several Districts are holding their convention this month and a representative from each Post within the District should be in attendance to allow the District to have a quorum to complete the business at hand. Show your support!

<u>RESOLUTIONS</u> The means by which changes are instituted within The American Legion start in the form of a resolution. Be sure to get your proposed resolutions approved through your Post and Squadron. Resolutions should be forwarded to your District Convention for endorsement/approval. Contact Adjutant Salak for a copy of the resolution template should you need one.

<u>MEMBERSHIP</u> We still have 3,332 members to renew and sign up to reach our goal of 28,236. Let's get all renewals collected and transmitted NOW! Next target date is March 11, so cards must be in Department by 9:00 am, Monday, March 9. A reminder to Post Adjutants to remit \$35.00 per membership card.

<u>MEMBERSHIP AWARDS</u> There are still a few membership awards that Posts and individuals are eligible to receive this year. A Stoldorf new member recruiting form is enclosed. Send the completed form to Headquarters by June 1, 2020 to be counted towards the individual awards. Contact Amanda at Headquarters with questions.

<u>DEPARTMENT CONVENTION</u> Legionnaires are encouraged to make reservations for the 2020 Department Convention June 25-28 in Kearney at the Ramada Inn (308-237-3141). Rooms are \$82.00 a night. We have a limited number of rooms so book early.

<u>CORNHUSKER BOYS' STATE</u> The deadline for receiving Cornhusker Boys' State applications is March 16. If you have not selected your Boys' State representative(s), we would suggest that you do so very soon and get the application and \$375 fee in the mail. Download applications at http://nebraskalegion.net/Programs/BState.html. Remember: Posts are to refrain from informing any boy of his selection until official notification has been received from Department Headquarters. Confirmations will be mailed to the sponsor no later than March 25.

Legionnaires who wish to volunteer as a staff member for the entire week of Cornhusker Boys' State (May 31- June 6) should contact Adjutant Salak by March 15. He will make selections by April 1 and notify those selected. DO NOT complete your background check until you have been notified of your selection. A background check is mandatory for those 18 years of age and older but does not include those volunteers who only hand out t-shirts on Sunday.

<u>VETERANS CRISIS LINE</u> There are far too many veterans in crisis; be it chronic pain, anxiety, depression, homelessness, etc. The Veterans Crisis Line is a tool that someone in crisis can use if/when life starts to feel overwhelming. See Nebraska Legion homepage for more information.

<u>LET'S PLAY BASEBALL!</u> Legion Baseball season has begun. Coaches and staff must complete a background check before the team's registration can be approved. Deadline changes – Registration, Fees and Insurance NLT May 15; Transfer forms sent to Department NLT May 31; Rosters by June 15. As always teams are encouraged to retain Insurance and Form 2s for 5 years. Class A Sr & Jr Area – July 17-21; Class A Sr & Jr State – July 25-29; Class A Sr Division Playoffs – July 31 – August 1; Class A Regional – August 5; Class B & C Jr Area – July 10-14; Class B & C Jr State – July 18-22; Class B & C Sr Area – July 24-28; Class B & C Sr State – August 1-5.

<u>EAGLE SCOUT-OF-THE-YEAR</u> Post Commanders are reminded that all applications received for Scout-of-the-Year must be signed by the Unit Leader and forwarded directly to Programs Director Brent Hagel-Pitt at Department by March 1. All eligible applicants will be considered for state-level cash scholarships awards. The state winner will represent Nebraska in the national contest for additional scholarships valued up to \$10,000.

JUNIOR LAW CADET Training of 30 boys and 30 girls will be held the week of June 22-25. The graduation ceremony is at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 25. The entry deadline for Posts submitting their Junior Law Cadet applications to Department is March 15. Department will forward the applications to the District Selection Committee for the interview process. Please note that a commitment to a law enforcement career is NOT required. Two boys and girls will be selected from each of the 14 districts. District 8 and 15 will be able to send their 1st alternate boy and girl. Contact Brent Hagel-Pitt for more information. The cost per cadet remains \$175.

<u>OPERATION SCHOOL TALK</u> Our Americanism Committee sponsors "OPERATION SCHOOL TALK" to educate and inform the youth on the principles and programs of The American Legion and our proud military service. The awards will be presented at Department Convention in Kearney.
